Scanning Asana for passwords and secrets

To scan Asana, from the menu select "File->Scan Asana". Then enter the information required. You need Personal Access Token to authenticate and scan Asana content and comments. To create API token go to URL <u>https://app.asana.com/0/my-apps</u>. Then select "Create new token" button. Make sure you copy the token and save it somewhere safe where you can later use it to scan with Flawnter.

API Version: This is the API version to use for the scan.

Base URL: Should be <u>https://app.asana.com</u>.

Auth Token: This is the Personal Access Token to authenticate to Asana.
